ORDER:-

The Hon'ble High Court in WP No. 16290 of 2007 and WP No. 2105 of 2023 underscored the pivotal role of the Competent Authority in regulating admissions to unaided institutions and for issuing operating guidelines. In compliance with the orders of the Hon'ble High Court, the Competent Authority and the Chairman, Andhra Pradesh State Council of Higher Education hereby issued the following operating guidelines for admission of candidates into APLAWCET/PGLCET – 2025 under Spot Quota.

1. The Competent Authority will issue admission schedule along with the guidelines for filling up of seats under spot quota and Management quota seats for each CET-2025 and they are binding to all Managements of the Colleges and Students.
2. The Universities concerned will not allow such candidates whose admissions are not approved/ratified by the Competent Authority to appear for examinations conducted by the Universities.
3. The Candidates have been asked to report at the respective institutions on or before reporting dates without fail. Seats left unfilled at the end of Final Phase are indicated in the vacancy position placed in website <https://cets.apsche.ap.gov.in>. Vacancy position (unfilled seats at the end of latest phase of counselling) of all colleges is placed in website while the vacancy of concerned college can be downloaded by logging in through college user in the department site.

4. The Convener APLWCET/PGLCET-2025 (Admissions) had not collected the original certificates of the candidate at the time of granting the provisional admission through counselling. Hence, the Principals of the Colleges concerned shall thoroughly verify the original certificates and collect all the photo copies of certificates and retain them.
5. On receipt of the vacant seats after completion of the final phase of admissions under Convener Quota, the College shall conduct internal sliding (where applicable), if any. **The candidates obtained seat in the internal sliding done by the college falls under spot quota and hence they are not eligible for fee reimbursement.**
6. The college concerned shall issue a notification in the state wide leading news daily inviting applications for filling up of seats in APLWCET/PGLCET -2025 under spot quota. The College shall provide detailed and complete information with regard to vacancies, eligibility of the criteria candidate, schedule of admissions, registration fee for the application, etc and upload in the College website.
7. The College shall arrive the vacancy position by following the procedure as given hereunder:
 - (i) Unfilled vacancies at the end of Final Phase are placed in respective college login portals of <https://cets.apsche.ap.gov.in>.
 - (ii) If same category candidate is not available, seat shall be filled with the candidate as per seat conversion matrix given below:

- (iii) The College shall arrive the total vacancies for Institutional spot admissions = Unfilled seats at the end of final Phase + Number not

reported from the list of allotted candidates + Number reported but cancelled after Final Phase.

8. The College shall issue applications to all the candidates who approached to the College and also receive filled in applications by following transparent procedures.
9. The College shall verify original certificates, as given hereunder, before preparation of merit list of the candidates before confirming admission. Only eligible candidates should be admitted. Admission shall be provisional until data is uploaded and approved by APSCH.
- (a) Eligibility for admission into a Course shall be as prescribed Educational qualifications given in APLAWCET/PGLCET-2025 Notification and as per the BCI and affiliating University regulations.
 - (b) SSC Certificate or equivalent.
 - (c) Intermediate Marks Memos
 - (d) Qualifying Examination Consolidated Marks Memo and Provisional Pass Certificate
 - (e) Residence Certificate (if applicable)
 - (f) APLAWCET/PGLCET - 2025 Rank Card (if qualified)
 - (g) APLAWCET/PGLCET -2025 Hall Ticket (if qualified)
 - (h) Caste Certificate
 - (i) Transfer Certificate
 - (j) EWS Certificate (if applicable)
10. The candidates shall fulfil the following eligibility criteria for admission into spot quota in APLAWCET/PGLCET-2025.
 - (a) **The candidates who have not taken admission so far are only eligible.** Candidates shall not be allowed for spot admission without verifying original certificates.
 - (b) The vacancies are to be filled firstly with candidates qualifying examination and secured rank in APLAWCET/PGLCET-2025.
 - (c) The vacancies are to be filled with those qualified in APLAWCET/PGLCET-2025 and fulfilling the eligibility criteria given in APLAWCET/PGLCET-2025 Notification. Eligibility for admission into 3 Year LLB, 5 Year LLB and LLM Courses are as follows:

S. No	Course	Qualifying Examination	Eligibility Criteria
1.	3 Year LLB	DEGREE	45% and above for OC Category 42% and above for BC Category 40% and above for SC/ST Category
2.	5 Year LLB	INTERMEDIATE	45% and above for OC Category 42% and above for BC Category 40% and above for SC/ST Category
3.	LLM	LLB DEGREE	Passed in LLB Degree

- (i) Eligibility for Admission into 3 year LLB course: The candidate for 3 year LLB course should have passed Graduation Degree 10+2+3 pattern (Regular/ Distance/Open/Correspondence) from any recognized university of India or outside or equivalent.

Note: The candidates who have passed Degree examination by single sitting without undergoing three years course either through regular or private or correspondence or Distance and those who obtained the degree through Open University directly without having any basic qualification are not eligible.

- (ii) Eligibility for Admission into 5 year LLB course: the candidate should have passed two year Intermediate Examination with 10+2 pattern (such as 11+1), 'A' level in Senior School Leaving certificate course from a recognized university of India or outside or equivalent.

Note: The applicants who have obtained 10+2 or graduation /post-graduation through open Universities system directly without having any basic qualification (i.e SSC) for prosecuting such studies are not eligible for admission into law courses.

- (iii) Candidates possessing the qualifying examination certificate from an AICTE/UGC recognised institution shall alone be considered for admission.
- (c) Candidates who satisfy the definition of Local/Non-Local, as per G.O.Ms.No.20 Higher Education Department Dt:12.05.2025, shall alone be granted admission.
- (d) Candidates whose degree is from other state but either of the parents resided for a period of 10 years in A.P state are eligible for Spot Admissions.

11. The College shall prepare and publish program wise merit list based on CET rank or qualifying marks by following transparent procedures as per the guidelines and following eligibility criteria of the candidates.

12. The Colleges shall upload the list of candidates admitted based on the merit list into APSCHE portal as per the schedules notified along with payment of registration and process fee as prescribed by the Competent Authority. Delay or failure in uploading may result in cancellation of admissions or withdrawal of affiliation.
13. Entering details of candidates admitted under spot admissions in the web portal along with attested or original certificates signed by the Principal are uploaded in the portal.
- (a) Eligibility for admission into a Course shall be as prescribed Educational qualifications given in APLAWCET/PGLCET - 2025 Notification
 - (b) SSC Certificate
 - (c) Intermediate Marks Memos
 - (d) Qualifying Examination Consolidated Marks Memo and Provisional Pass Certificate
 - (e) Residence Certificate (if applicable)
 - (f) APLAWCET/PGLCET - 2025 Rank Card (if qualified)
 - (g) APLAWCET/PGLCET - 2025 Hall Ticket (if qualified)
 - (h) Caste Certificate
 - (i) Transfer Certificate
 - (j) EWS Certificate valid for the year 2025-26 for OC candidates who want to claim reservation under EWS category. The EWS certificates obtained for the previous years shall not be considered.
 - (k) Aadhar number (not mandatory)
- Upload the scanned copies of all above certificates for Verification and for ratification of spot admissions made.
14. The Competent Authority will verify the list of admitted candidates and validated the same with reference to the GOs and as per the prescribed procedures.
15. The Competent Authority shall approve and ratify the validated list and communicate the proceedings to the college concerned.
16. If any deficiencies found during validation of admitted lists, the college concerned shall rectify the deficiencies within the stipulated time and obtain ratification of such admitted candidates.
17. The admitted candidates who are not fulfilled the required eligibility conditions will be summarily rejected by the Competent Authority.
18. The Institution shall undertake the responsibility on the irregularities noticed by the Competent Authority.

19. The Competent Authority shall have the authority to impose fine or to initiate action or both for violation of these guidelines and the Instructions as per the GOs in vogue.

20. Proceedings for the ratification/rejection of admissions made after verification of eligibility criteria, the Council will inform the date from which approval proceedings can be downloaded through the website.

21. The College shall adhere the schedule for conducting spot admissions in APLAWCET/PGLCET-2025.

22. The Colleges shall collect the following processing fee from each candidate admitted through APLAWCET/PGLCET-2025 Spot admissions.

23. The College shall

- (i) Comply the spot admission schedule issued by the Competent Authority.
- (ii) Upload admitted students' data promptly in the APSCH portal as per schedule.
- (iii) Take ratification of admissions prior to commencement of class work.

24. The College shall not

- (i) Admit students beyond the sanctioned intake and beyond the prescribed schedule.
- (ii) Allow the students to attend class without the approval of the admission from the competent authority.
- (iii) conduct spot admissions of total seats under convener quota without participating in the counselling.
- (iv) Admit students without verifying original certificates and other supporting documents.
- (v) Collect excess fees or amounts not prescribed by APSCHE or APHERMC.
- (vi) Violate rules issued by the Government / Competent Authority.
- (vii) The colleges shall not continue any candidates who are not present in the current list of allotments. They shall be directed to report to the new institution immediately.

25. Please Note that the Students admitted through Spot Admissions (i.e.) leftover seats of the Convener quota subsequently in the Institutional Spot Admissions are not eligible for Tuition Fee Reimbursement Vide G.O.Ms.No.66 Social Welfare (SW.EDN.2) Department Dated 08.09.2010.

Note: These Guidelines are not applicable for University colleges and self-financed programs of Universities and Government Colleges.
